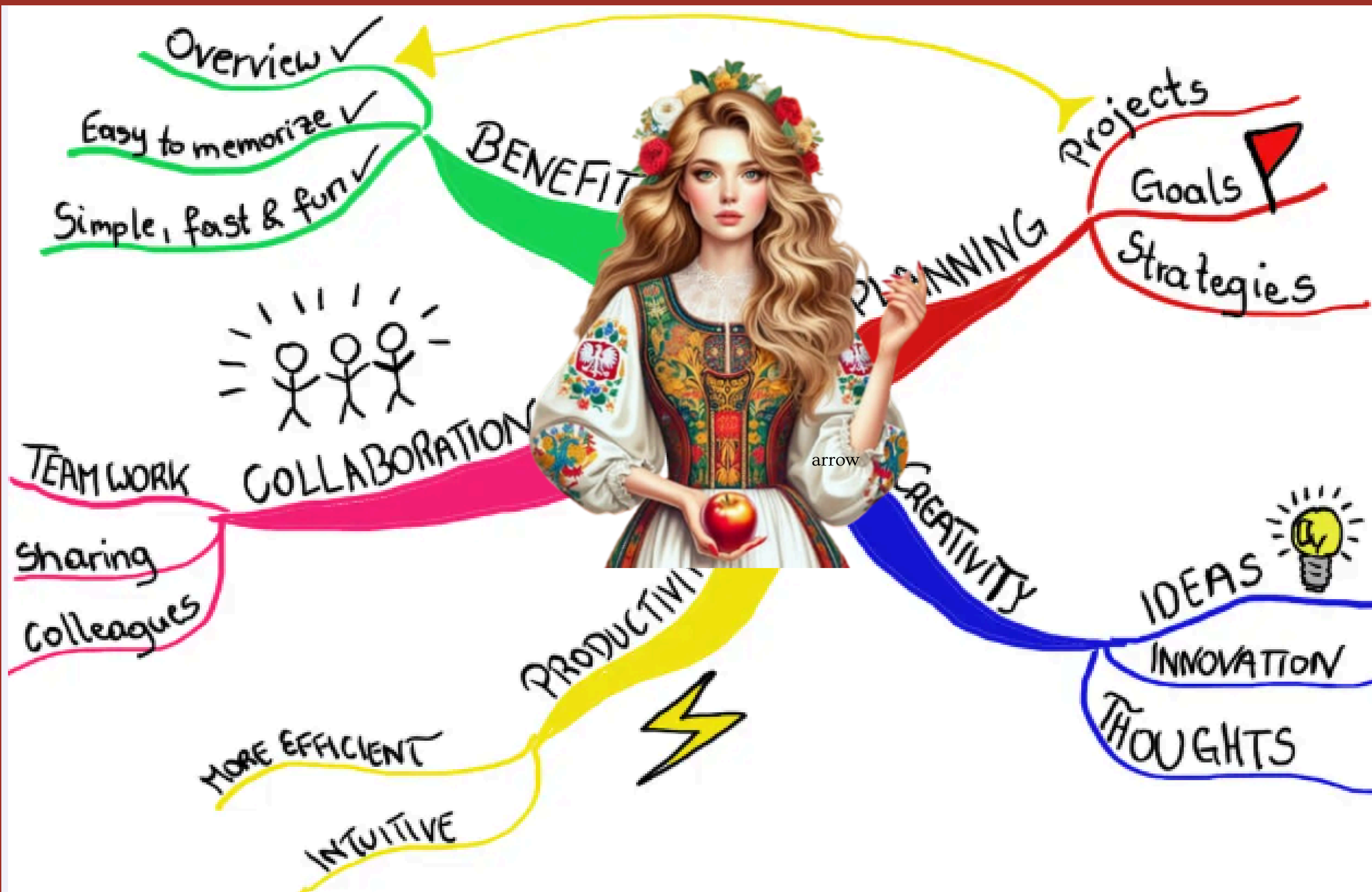

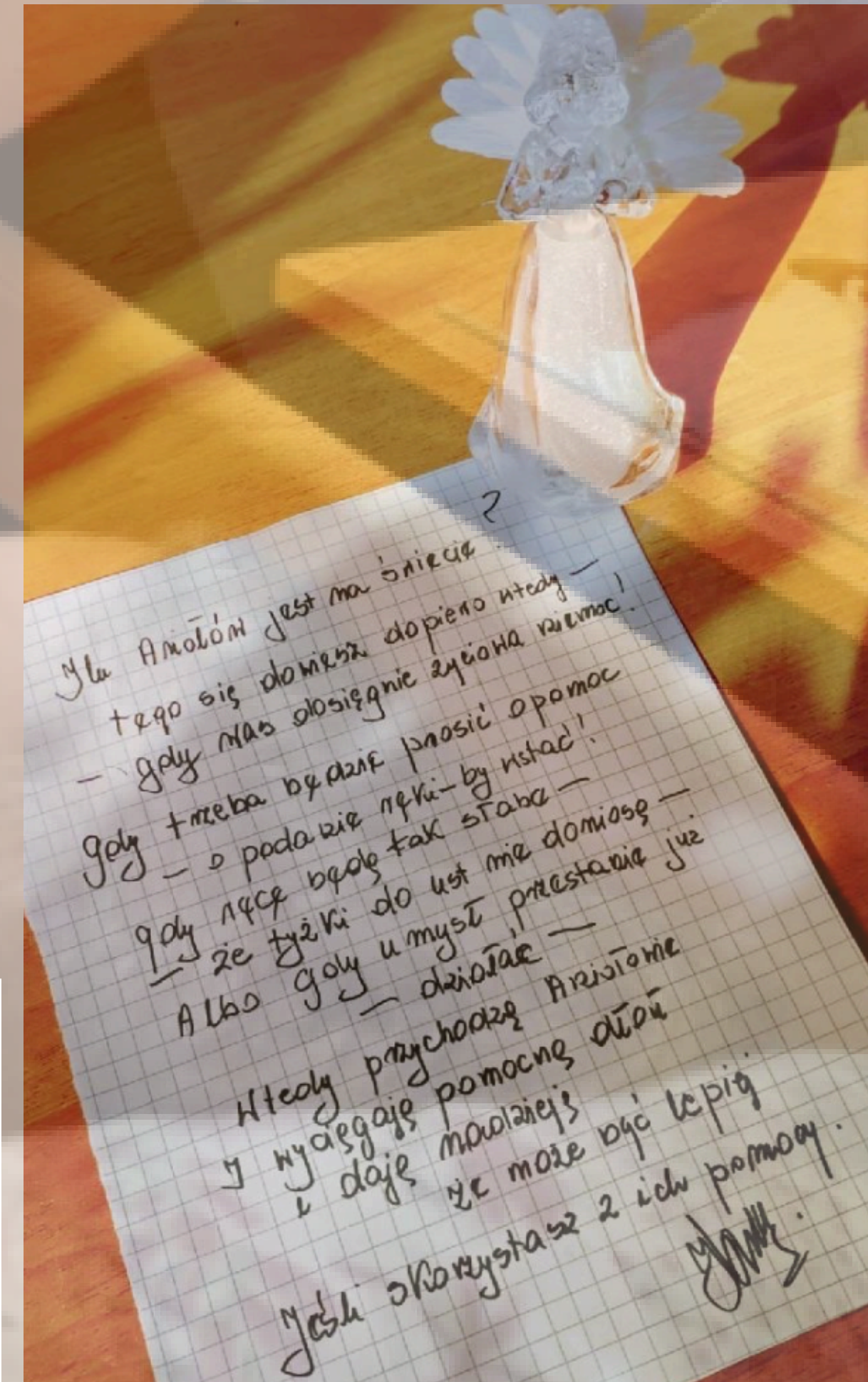
The walking pilgrimage starts on 9th August 2025. The pilgrims want to cover 160 kilometres in five days.

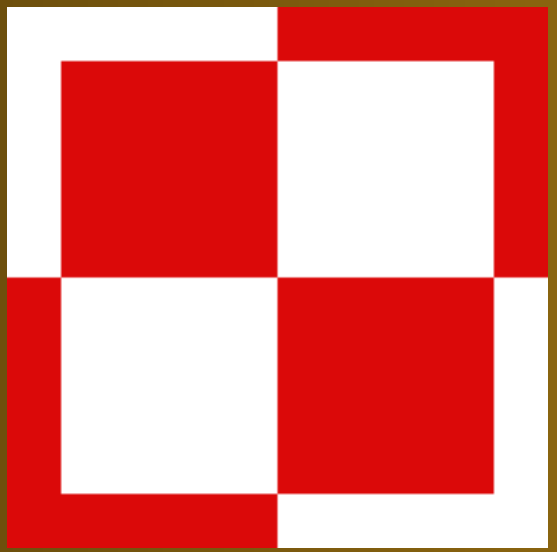
