Warsaw – a historical city



Warsaw's history is both diverse and turbulent. Last century alone it went from Russian subjugation to being called the Paris of the North, before the utter destruction of World War II when the city was reduced virtually to rubble, only to rise again under Soviet influence. The Old Town especially shows the remarkable resilience of the city, having been thoroughly reconstructed and being listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Old Town is also the starting point of the Royal Route, an avenue that runs from the Royal Castle – the seat of Polish Kings, past the Royal Łazienki Park – a Palace garden complex – and down to the Wilanów Royal Palace. During the communist era, the city was shaped by the grey, utilitarian architecture of socialism, dominated by the looming presence of the Palace of Science and Culture. Since Poland's political transformation, however, huge improvements have been made and Warsaw has seen rapid and dramatic changes. Now it is an inspiring place, creative and modern. ■

Warsaw – City of Chopin

Fryderyk Chopin is famed around the world as a composer and pianist. Not so many people know that **Warsaw is the city of Chopin**, which was a very special place for the composer. It was in the capital city that the Chopin family lived for Fryderyk's early years, and it was here that the artist spent the first half of his life. Fryderyk learned to play the piano in Warsaw, charming aristocrats with his magnificent concert performances, and attracting interest from the city's press. However, he remained a typical Warsaw boy, walking round the city's streets, learning foreign languages, picking up girls, and joking around with his friends at fashionable cafes.

Nowadays, there are **many places on the streets of Warsaw where traces of Fryderyk Chopin can still be found** (and we're not just talking about the composer's heart, which was brought back here after his death). Use our free mobile applications and website to find out how interesting Chopin's Warsaw was, and still is! His music still resonates today as an expression of Poland's passionate nature, its one of a kind culture and the highs and lows of its history.

Throughout the summer, there are **public concerts** to be enjoyed in the **Royal Łazienki Park** where a statue of Chopin watches over the crowds of eager listeners. And all year round you can hear his music while resting on one of the many **multimedia Chopin benches** for a quick break from exploring the composer's picturesque city. And for a more in-depth look at the life of the great man, the Fryderyk Chopin Museum is very modern and interactive and boasts the largest collection of the composer's memorabilia in the world. Just a short trip away from Warsaw, you can add to your Chopin experience by visiting the nearby cities of **Żelazowa Wola – the composer's birthplace**, and Sanniki – which will show you all you wanted to know about Chopin and the typical Mazovian folk culture that influenced his work. ■

The Fryderyk Chopin Museum at Warsaw's Ostrogski Palace is one of the most highly acclaimed modern biographical museums in Europe. The multimedia exhibition expertly displays the world's richest and most varied collection of Chopin memorabilia – from his life and his works. Chopin and His Europe International Music Festival is a magnet for all lovers of classical and contemporary music. Organised every August since 2005 by the Fryderyk Chopin Institute, every year there is a new overarching theme followed by the outstanding Polish and international artists invited to play there.

Open-air concerts are held at the feet of the monument to Fryderyk Chopin every Sunday from May until September. The concerts welcome outstanding pianists from all over the world and are free of charge. All you need to do is sit in the park and listen to the wonderful music.

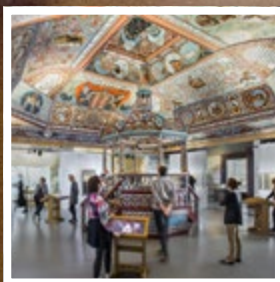

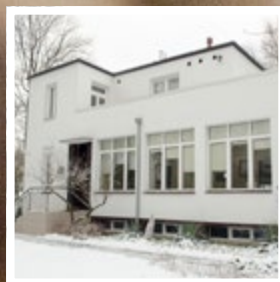

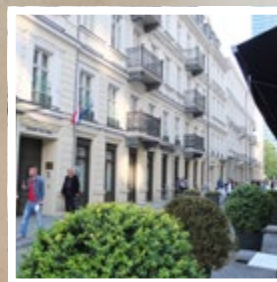

Warsaw has long had a strong connection with the Jewish world. Before World War II, over 30 per cent of Warsaw's population was Jewish, leaving Warsaw with the second largest Jewish population in the world, behind New York. That population enjoyed Jewish schools, libraries, theatres and sports clubs and had many famous celebrities. Warsaw was home to the author and Nobel Prize winner, Isaac Bashevis Singer, the pianist and composer Władysław Szpilman – known from the film *“The Pianist”*, and the outstanding actress Ida Kamińska.

However, the atrocities of the Second World War changed everything, with the Nazis establishing a **Jewish ghetto**, systematically exterminating the inhabitants and destroying synagogues. In today's Warsaw you can still find a lot of places that hark back to this tragic history: The Monument of the Ghetto Heroes next to **POLIN Museum**, the monument of Umschlagplatz, the place from where Jews were transported to the Treblinka death camp, and the sign of the ghetto wall along the pavements. POLIN Museum, the Jewish Theatre, Grzybowski Square, Prózna Street and the Nożyk Synagogue are the places most associated with Jewish culture today, but there are stories everywhere. In **Zabiński Villa** you can hear the incredible tale of the Warsaw Zoo director and his wife, and their heroic work in saving Jewish people life, immortalised in a recent film. Every autumn there is also a **festival of Jewish culture** – *“Singer's Warsaw”* – which aims to spread awareness of the richness of Jewish culture and how things used to be. ■

POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews

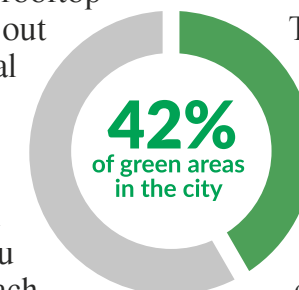
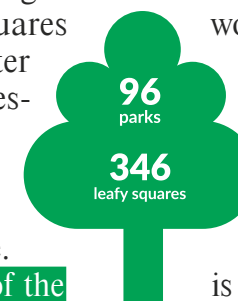


Warsaw is a green and refreshing destination with its 346 leafy squares and 96 parks covering a quarter of the city. The largest and most impressive of these is the **Royal Łazienki Park and Palace** complex covering 76 ha of parkland in the middle of the city and containing some beautiful architecture. There is also the incredible **green roof of the University Library**, one of the largest rooftop gardens in Europe, with a view looking out over the Vistula River and the National Stadium.

Warsaw's **river banks** are considered to be the summer centre of the city, with much to offer on both sides. Here you can relax on one of eight municipal beaches, rent sports equipment, go on a bicycle tour

along the river or take a cruise on traditional wooden boats. There is also a free river ferry during the summer months. The Vistula River in Warsaw is particularly unique due to its natural values. The right bank of the river is entirely wild and home to beavers, terns and even moose, which you might catch a glimpse of if you're lucky. The area is protected by the Natura 2000 programme.

The left bank has also undergone extensive renovation to make it into a vibrant and interesting place to spend time. Close by, near to the Royal Castle, there is the **Multimedia Fountain Park**. This is also a venue for many cultural events, primarily **Wianki** (the summer solstice celebration) in June, and the Feast of the Vistula in September. ■

Cuisine

Polish cuisine is not simply **pierogi** and **sausage** – though they play their role and come in many shapes and flavours. However, most Varsovian dining tables will see a lot of pork, with ample amounts of beef, poultry and fish. **Soups** play a very important role, with many to try from and ones to favour every palate. It is also true that Varsovians have a sweet tooth and enjoy their cakes: whether it is one of the many cheesecakes, or apple pies, or traditional poppy-seed cakes and gingerbread, popular especially over Christmas time. During Easter, there are frosting-covered yeast cakes and an obligatory addition to every Easter meal is “**mazurki**” – a confection entirely unknown outside of Poland. Poland is also known for its famous **vodka**, best served chilled in small shot glasses and swallowed in one go. Warsaw boasts a galaxy of restaurants and a huge variety of cuisines, Polish and others from around the world. We can recommend a few that serve Polish dishes ►

Recommended restaurants for MICE:

Smaki Warszaw

An elegant restaurant that offers dishes from Polish cuisine, especially specialties from pre- and post-war Warsaw. **Ul. Żurawia 47/49, www.smakiwarszawy.pl**

Piąta Ćwiartka

Warszawa Wschodnia

AleGloria

In the very heart of the city, strawberry bushes are in bloom and white geese have flown in. The new venture shows Polish cuisine in a different dimension. Recipes of Polish cuisine are combined with better or less known traditional dishes to present a new image of a culinary art. **Plac Trzech Krzyży 3, www.alegloria.pl**

E. Wedel Chocolate Lounge

This address of the cafe and shop has been unchanged since 1894, though the Wedel factory and first flagship store appeared in 1851. Old-Fashioned Shop serves Wedel breakfasts, which consist of excellent bread, cheese, freshly-squeezed juice, tea, coffee and of course cups of chocolate. **Ul. Szpitalna 8, www.wedelpijalnie.pl**

Warsaw's Halls

One of the recent developments in Warsaw has been the reinvention of former trade centres, originally intended to bring Warsaw's open-air markets inside, to be better organised and more hygienic, and now, with the prevalence of modern supermarkets, have changed again to enjoy a new lease of life. In Warsaw there are three main halls, each with historical aspects.



Hala Mirowska

The **Koszyki** market hall has come to be known as the ‘People's bazaar’. It reopened in the autumn of 2016, and found its way into the hearts of the city residents as Warsaw's social and culinary centre. It offers a range of street food stalls from around the world, in one location around a long central bar, together with high quality shops offering fresh products for anyone who wants to recreate the sumptuous smells and tastes in their own home. Hala Koszyki is Warsaw's answer to similar such investments

in places like New York, London, Lisbon and Florence, bustling with activity around and buzzing with interesting chatter. (Address: ul. Koszykowa 63)

Hala Mirowska has been among the largest and most interesting markets in Warsaw for over a century. Rebuilt after the war, it was known as a place where you could find everything, and hosted a large, colourful and fragrant flower market. Now it is a place beloved by chefs and foodies, with something for even the most demanding of recipes... if you look hard enough, as you can find almost everything there. (Address: Plac Mirowski 1)

A new food hall, **Hala Gwardii** – opened at the end of September 2017 in the centre of War-

saw. A great place for breakfast, lunch or dinner, to pick up some shopping at the food market or in specialised shops, or just soak up the atmosphere. The offer in Hala Gwardii is diversified. Street food style booths offer a range of dishes from all around the world and beer or wine is available. Hala Gwardii is open from Friday to Sunday. The food market is open from 9 am to 8 pm on Friday and Saturday, and from 10 am to 5 pm on Sunday. (Address: Plac Żelaznej Bramy 1) ■

NIGHT MARKET

This is Warsaw's first ever street food night market, located on the postal platforms of Warsaw's former Main Railway Station (Warszawa Główna). It is a gathering of stalls with tempting food from all corners of the globe, independent traders, merchants, and music modelled on the famous night markets of Asia. Warsaw's Night Market gathers together many of the most enticing street food sellers with a wide range of culinary delights. The Market is open every summer weekend from evening until late at night.



BREAKFAST MARKET

If the Night Market is too late for you, then think about Warsaw's Breakfast Market, with a picnic atmosphere where families and friends can eat breakfast outside on the grass, take part in workshops and do some shopping. Every weekend, visitors can sample regional specialties from around Poland and the world, as well as a wide range of original dishes served up just for the



market. The Breakfast Market takes place throughout the summer months, outside in the open air of various parks and green areas, moving between the districts of Żoliborz, Mokotów, Praga and the Powiśle neighbourhood.

VEGETARIAN WARSAW

According to the website “Happy Cow”, Warsaw is one of the most welcoming places for vegans and vegetarians. The website maps meat-free restaurants around the world, and speaks highly of the Polish capital. It is the only Eastern European city on their list. Warsaw takes pride in having a large number of vegan restaurants.

In the footsteps of communism

After World War II, while the Old Town was rebuilt from pictures and memories, the rest of Warsaw was given a new look to reflect the new era. Architects were tasked with rebuilding the city in a new style of design: “socialist in content and national in form”. This architectural heritage of socialist realism is most visible in Warsaw through a visit to the **Palace of Culture and Science**, which looms over the city and which celebrated its 60th anniversary in 2015. Walk around Parade Square and imagine listening to the propaganda-filled speeches of the leaders of the Polish People’s Republic. At **Constitution Square (Plac Konstytucji)**, in the **Marszałkowska Housing District**, there are more impressive sculptures from the 1950s on display. To feel the spirit of the past era, try a visit to one of the remaining **milk bars** – fast food canteens from that time, offering inexpensive, home style traditional Polish cooking, and enjoy their unique atmosphere where time has stood still. Nostalgia is so strong, that now there are new bars styled on the post-communist ones.

Visit the private **museum of Life Under Communism** and hear stories about life with empty shops and long queues. ■

Warsaw is almost unrecognisable to anyone who has not visited it in a while, and is constantly changing and up-dating. However, some of its quirky character and many of its cult places are still there to be discovered. Some of these places hark back to a by-gone age and depict what everyday life was like in the post-war communism of the Polish People's Republic (PRL). Others take these old buildings and renovate them in exciting and interesting ways to delight the people who use them or visit. See what makes Warsaw special!



Warsaw's Neons

Warsaw's streets once glittered with neon lights – during the great cold war 'neonisation' campaign, the capital was lit up from every building it seemed. That is documented and remembered in the amazing **Neon Museum**, which has recovered and protects the post-war neon advertising that once flooded the streets of Polish cities with light and colour. The museum's collection is contained within one of Poland's oldest post-industrial factory buildings, itself renovated and modernized to become a thriving cultural heart of the capital, **Soho Factory**. This combination is perfect for the museum, giving the venue an atmosphere like no other. Well worth a visit, the area is also a unique and stunning backdrop that has been used for product launches, fashions

shoots, corporate functions and cultural excursions alike.

Poster Museum

Polish posters are considered to be conceptual masterpieces and beautiful works of art in their own right. Wilanów's Poster Museum has a collection of 36,000 Polish Posters and nearly 25,000 Foreign Posters, making the museum one of the largest, and certainly the oldest, of its kind. And to see classic posters in a different setting, visit the **Relaks café** in the Mokotów district, with its walls covered with posters in rotating displays, combining past masters with upcoming talent.

Milk bars

No visit to Warsaw would be complete without a visit to a milk bar (bar mleczny). This is an essential Polish sightseeing experience and a step back in time to when meat and fresh vegetables were scarce, and state-run restaurants served cheap meals. The milk bars of today remain cheap, cafeteria-style establishments that offer comfort foods – soups, **pierogi** (dumplings) as well as a meat-and-potatoes menu (quite literally). They offer a wider variety of foods than was once available, but the basic concept remains. There are a few left in the capital and are not only an inexpensive meal, but with the right attitude they are also a fun cultural adventure.

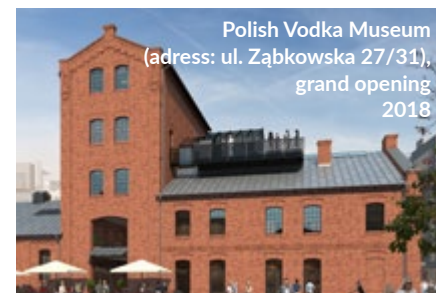
Ząbkowska Street – Praga district

Warsaw's Praga district is enjoying a cultural resurgence and that is certainly true of Ząbkowska Street, once

of the area's **oldest streets** dating back to the turn of the century when the capital was just expanding across the river. Pre-WWI it was mainly a Jewish area, with upper middle-class traders and entrepreneurs adding to the bustling street life, and the street was already known as an centre of entertainment. Ząbkowska Street has worked hard to retain that reputation, with many restaurants and bars attracting tourists, students



and hipsters. These places offer Polish and Czech specialties at decent prices and in a trendier atmosphere than some other districts of Warsaw, and has developed as an artist hub, where many musicians and painters are still finding inspiration. Close by, the **Praga Zoo Market** was established in 2016, modelled on the Berlin vintage bazaar and flea market in Mauerpark. Visitors can find porcelain, glass, fabric, retro clothes and accessories, toys, old books, vinyl as well as the work of modern designers.



Parade Square

Parade Square was designed as an open urban place at the very centre of Warsaw, both accessible and attractive for residents and tourists. During the summer, the Square becomes an arena for a wide range of freely available cultural and recreational events. The central point of the Square is a **long table**, a symbolic space around which there is a series of communal events, including meet-



ups, debates, workshops, public consultations and bottom-up initiatives.

Warszawa Powiśle

If you only have time for one night out in Warsaw, then get your evening off to a great start at Warszawa Powiśle – good beer, good food and amazing location. And it's not just evenings – try their breakfasts, or pierogi, or rest in a big, comfy deck chair. It has a great vibe, and an interesting history – the structure used to be a **ticket booth** for the neighbouring train station.

Fotoplastikon

Travel back in time with the Warsaw Fotoplastikon! This fascinating place allows viewers to watch changing three-dimensional images, and has archives with over 3,000 original photographs from Warsaw and around the globe. Built in the early 20th century, it is the **only one in Poland** – and one of very few anywhere in the world that remains in perfect working condition.

Mysia 3 – department store

This is an alternative department store in a former censorship office from the Communist era. Venturing inside you will find a curated crop of Polish and international brands across five floors. There is much to do here, not least browsing through

the cut-out dresses and oversize blazers, but also catching up on the latest offers in the interior **design store**, or coming across a piece of delicate handmade jewellery. There is also a photo exhibition for you to look at... or simply enjoy a coffee in the back-yard cafeteria.

Iluzjon – post-war modernist cinema

Not many of the post-war, modernist, small cinemas remain in Warsaw. However, the former Stolica cinema, now called Iluzjon, is still going strong. It was built in 1953 and was renovated not long ago. It shows classic movies and the latest films. Don't forget to check out a very nice park around it.

Museum of Hunting and Horsemanship

According to its profile, the museum combines the themes of hunting and horsemanship – it is unique in Europe, with the added value of being located in the picturesque Łazienki Royal Park – a green heart of Warsaw. In the museum you can find **exhibitions about nature** – rare or extinct animals and birds alongside more exotic fauna.

SCIENTIFIC COMMUNITY

A capital city like Warsaw is naturally incredibly complex to manage and organise, given the multiple diverse and often contradictory opinions, directions and areas to control. All this makes finding an effective development policy a real challenge, not only as a responsibility of the local government, but also as for the numerous entities influencing the quality of the economy in Warsaw. With this in mind, Warsaw has implemented a **Triple Helix concept**, which implies that the innovation of the knowledge-based economy is a result of close cooperation between three sectors: science, business and local administration.

Warsaw perceives the development of a modern, knowledge-based economy as a strategic and major goal. The city is constantly increasing the impact of the research sector on the economy by developing research infrastructure, transferring knowledge and technology between science and business (centres

of advanced services and databases) and increasing access to innovation support instruments (consulting, training, scholarships, grants etc.).

Warsaw is one the most significant scientific hubs in Europe, with **over 150 scientific institutions** and a multitude of professors and researchers being active members of international associations.

The local authorities are aware that developing a network of cooperative relationships positively influences not only mutual relations between companies and scientific communities, but also builds an important segment of the economy through the MICE sector. Therefore, the City of Warsaw, using the synergy of public and private entities associated within **Warsaw Tourism Organisation**, offers wide support for meeting planners considering bringing their congresses, conferences, fairs or other events to Warsaw. ■

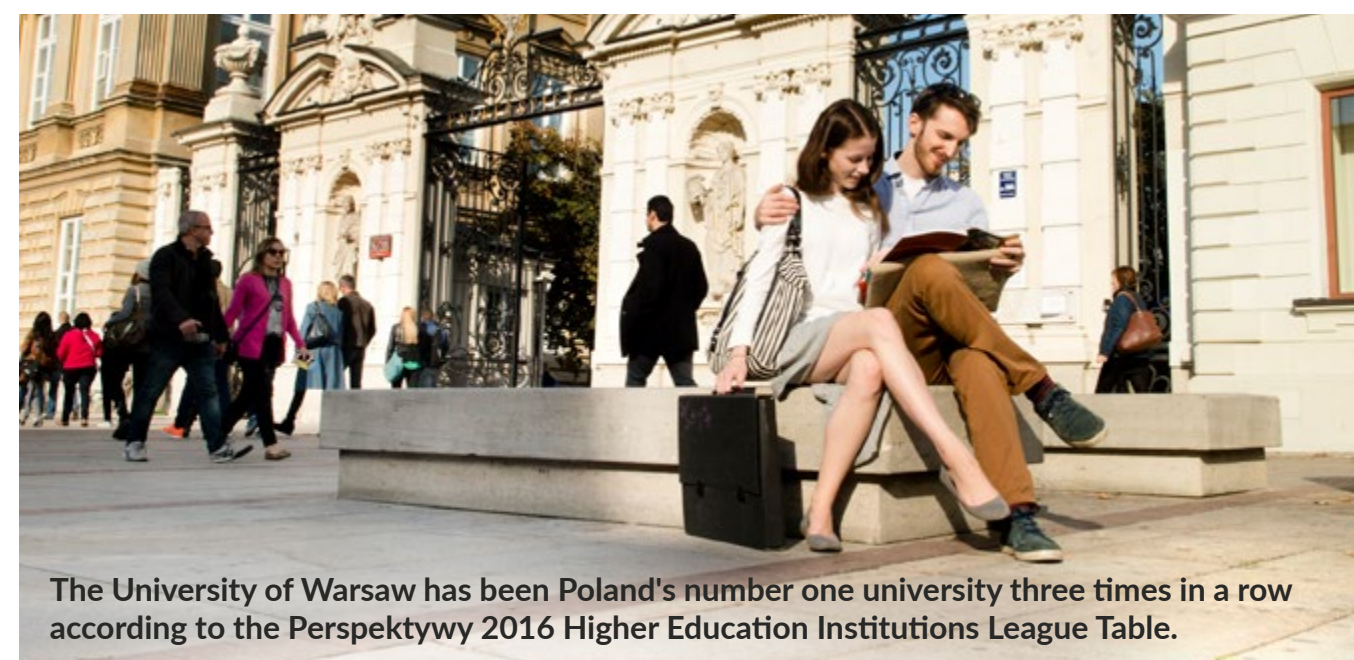

By plane

By train

Warsaw is also well connected to other European cities by rail. There are **3 train stations** in Warsaw providing international and intercity train services. They are well connected to the public transportation network.



Visa regulations

Poland is in the **Schengen zone**. Visitors from non-EU countries must hold a passport valid for at least three months beyond the length of stay. Participants requiring a visa should apply immediately to a consular office or a diplomatic mission of the Republic of Poland in their country in order to avoid a delayed arrival to the event. Please note that the visa application procedure can take up to two weeks.



Getting around

If you are sightseeing in the Old Town or wandering around the Palace of Culture and Science area, you might find it easier and more interesting to go by foot. Otherwise, take Warsaw's quick, safe and efficient public transport system of **metro, trams, buses and night buses**.



while travelling back in time to the 1950s, you can hitch a ride on the **historic "T" tram line**, or as an alternative ride the city offers trips along the Vistula River by **watertrams** or ferries. Finally, there is the option of taking a **rickshaw** around the Krakowskie Przedmieście area. ■

With Veturilo, Warsaw joins the other cities offering a bike rental system. Available from March until November, it opens the city up to bike rides near and (relatively) far. The past year marked an absolute record in the city bike's popularity. Already as many as 610,000 people have accounts in the Warsaw system, and have rented bikes a record-breaking eight million times so far. Warsaw's Veturilo public bike system is one of the largest and one of the most popular systems in Europe.

Reduta Banku Polskiego is a unique place in Warsaw. 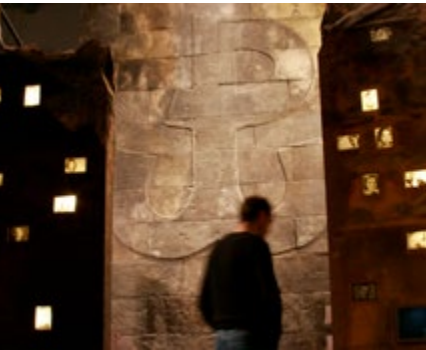

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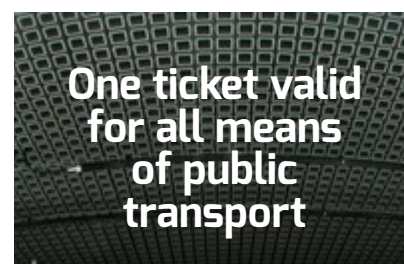

The next stage of construction of metro **line M2** is its extension adding six new stations: three in the western direction and three in the eastern – north direction. The whole western section is located in the Wola district, and the eastern – north section runs through the Praga and Targówek districts.
